FORT GRIFFIN SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT Board of Directors met in a Called Meeting, Wednesday, May 6, 2026, at 609 Railroad Street, Albany, Texas.

President McKelvain presided and called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m. Board members present: Ted Tidwell, Robert Montgomery, Trent Tankersley, Ben Hale and Sam Snyder. Employees present: Tyler George and Carrie Holson. Visitors present: none.

There were no visitor comments.

President McKelvain opened discussion for Canvassing of Election and requested Holson review the election results. Holson explained the process for Early voting, including the Early Voting ballot Board and their duties, custodian of keys, and the mail-in ballot process. She also informed the board of the issues that had arisen throughout the process and how they were addressed. Holson read the election results for each candidate with final total being:


Robert Montgomery	89
Ted Tidwell	97
Ben Hale	89
Lori Rohloff	42
Beverly Campbell	39

The board discussed the cost of having 4 polling places and asked how many voters had voted in each location. Holson reported: Albany- 49 voters; Breckenridge -43 voters; Moran -25 voters; and Throckmorton -23 voters. Snyder stated he feels the need to reevaluate the number of polling locations before the next election based on the number of voters.

Snyder made a motion to approve the results and the Canvassing of the May 2, 2026 election. Tankersley seconded the motion; all voted in favor; the motion carried.

There was no further discussion or action.

Snyder moved to adjourn at 12:52 pm. Motion seconded by Tankersley; all voting for, motion carried.
